

Complex – scents, fruits and flowers  
Corked – mouldy cork  
Heady – high in alcohol  
Lively – fresh young wine  
Musty – unpleasant  
Sappy – fine young wine  
Sulphur – preservative for cheap wine  
Yeasty – denotes fermentation in bottles of wine

### **Taste**

Apples – malic acid in young wine  
Black Currants – smell, flavour in reds  
Earthy – common quality in Rhône's  
Flowery – attractive scent  
Grapey – fresh grape  
Honey – noble rot in sweet wine
